Curriculum: Content & Strategies

Modern distance learning methods utilizing video conferences and online assignments are less effective than traditional classroom teaching. Helpful Hint: If you CANNOT replace the "owner" word(s) with "my," you DO NOT need to use an apostrophe.

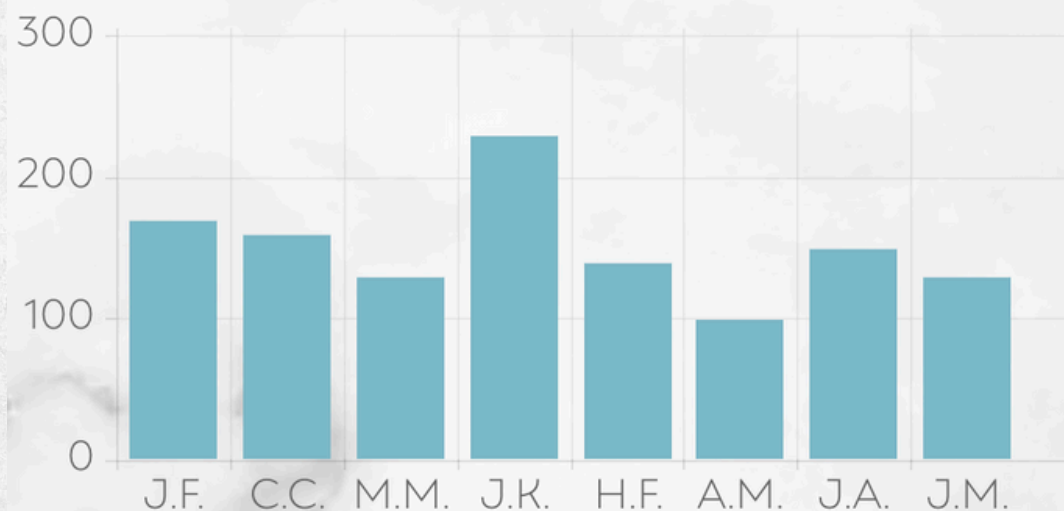
